OUTLINE OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEMS

- 1. *Core Course:* A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.
- 2. *Elective Course:* Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the

discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.

- a. <u>Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course</u>: Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).
- b. *Dissertation/Project:* An elective course designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study/support study to a project work, and a candidate studies such a course on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member is called dissertation/project.
- c. <u>Generic Elective (GE) Course</u>: An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective.

P.S.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective.

3. <u>Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)</u>: The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). "AECC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement; i. Environmental Science and ii. English/MIL Communication. These are mandatory for all disciplines. SEC courses are value- based and/or skillbased and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc.

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): Environmental Science, English Communication/MIL Communication.

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge.

Introducing Research Component in Under-Graduate Courses

Project work/Dissertation is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing /exploring a real life situation / difficult problem. A Project/Dissertation work would be of 6 credits. A Project/Dissertation work may be given in lieu of a discipline specific elective paper.

Reservation Policy:

SC/ ST Candidates

- Vide Govt. order No. 905-TW/EC dated 12th Sept., 1995 and EDN No.437/2014 dated 2nd April, 2014. 22% and 6% of total number of seats in each subject shall be reserved for SC and ST candidates respectively.
- SC/ST/ candidates, only from West Bengal, are eligible for reservation benefits. If adequate number of ST candidates is not available, seats should be filled up by SC candidates and vice versa.
- An SC/ST candidate short listed for admission should have marks in the qualifying examination which is not lower by more than 25% of the marks obtained by the last candidate short listed for admission in the merit list in the general category.
- A candidate of the reserved category, who may be admitted in the general merit list on the basis of his/her marks is not to be considered in the reserved category Each SC/ST candidate should secure the minimum marks criteria that has been prescribed for that subject

OBC (A) & OBC (B) Candidates

• From 2014 additional reservations for OBC (A) and OBC (B) categories are being enforced as per rules. OBC-A/ OBC-B candidates, only from West Bengal, are eligible.
